

Affiliated to Swim England South East Region and Hampshire County ASA

Monthly Swimming Fees from 1st September 2019 – 31st August 2020.

Swimming fees are payable on the 1st of the month throughout the year (they are divided equally over 12 months) through Team Unify by Debit or Credit Card payment.

The monthly fee comprises of two elements. The first covers all aspects of Club Membership and the second is a Training Fee which varies depending on squad. This Training Fee reflects the pool and gym time offered to each squad and the level of teaching/coaching offered.

A member wishing to resign membership of the Club must give to the Secretary **written notice** (email is sufficient) of his/her resignation, **one month in advance** please to allow the club time to fill the swimmers place.

N.B. Non payment of monies owed to the club may result in the swimmer NOT being allowed to swim until debts are cleared.
