Entering races

Entries will appear on TU Events over the next few days. The closing date for the 100s and 50s will be 1st November. No late entries will be considered as we will need to carefully plan the sessions and timings. If you are struggling with entering please email openmeets@farehamnomads.co.uk.. Using Time trials for Club Champs

Due to it being very unlikely that we will be able to hold a Club Championships during the 2020/21 swimming season we plan to use the times recorded during club time trials throughout the season (including those held recently in September / October) to run a virtual championship.

Results for all time trials will count. If you swim the same event more than once we will take the fastest time.

Results will be published to the website and you will be able to track progress throughout the year.

The rules regarding qualifying events will be the same as previous years:

- 1. Awards will be made for the individual age groups: 8 yrs/U, 9 yrs, 10 yrs, 11 yrs, 12 yrs, 13 yrs, 14 yrs, 15 yrs & 16 yrs -24 yrs, Masters (25 yrs & over). Age will be as at 31st December 2020. This will be even though some times will be recorded in 2021 as we want to ensure we run a club championships in each year and do not end up doubling up in 2021.
- 2. Awards will be based on FINA points for the swimmers top 8 races (6 for the 9 year old age group). A swimmers top 8 qualifying results must include 2x50m races, 2x100m races (free, back, breast or fly), 1x200m form race (back, breast or fly), best of 200m free or 400m free and 1xIM. If a swimmer does not compete in 8 qualifying races then the results they have got will be used to determine their placing (So, for example a swimmer with 4 good qualifying results could still win their age group).

For 9 year olds the 6 races must include 2 x 50m, 1 x 100m and an IM.

- 3. If swimmers are on level points after all races have been completed the award will go to the swimmer with the highest-ranking swim (using FINA points).
- 4. Each boy and girl ranked 1^{st} in each age group from 9 years up will receive the Perpetual Championship shield which they may retain until the last date of the 2021 Club Championships. In addition, each boy and girl ranked 1^{st} , 2^{nd} & 3^{rd} overall in each age group from 9 years up will receive a trophy.

We hope that we will be able to have a socially distanced celebration in the Summer to award trophies etc.
